

Lincolnshire English Attainment Project 2019

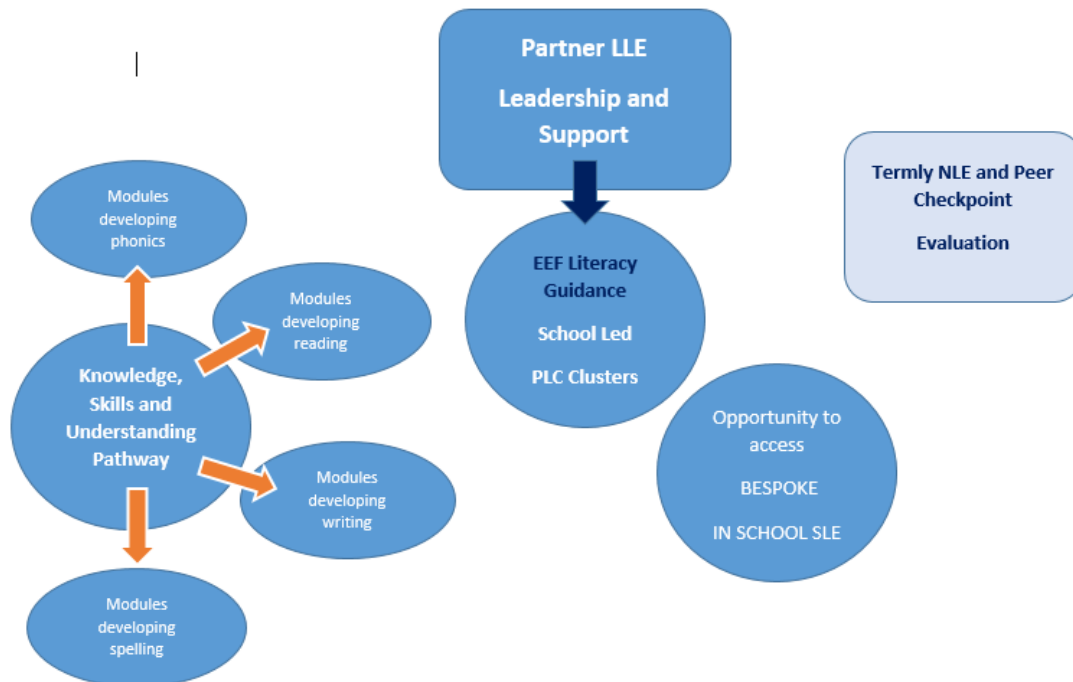
Project summary

LEAP19, Lincolnshire English Attainment Project 2019, is a English focussed Lincolnshire School Improvement Programme which targets focusing on raising attainment for disadvantaged children through the effective implementation of evidence-based practice as identified in the EEF guidance documents – “Improving Literacy in Keystage 1” and “Improving Literacy in Keystage 2”

Strategies addressed will target classroom teaching and learning as well as strategic subject leadership. The aim of the project is to increase the knowledge, pedagogy and confidence of both children and teachers in this curriculum area throughout the school to facilitate positive progress.

The project follows the Core PLC model of networks, providing support for senior leaders and teachers through identifying and accessing new and proven teaching strategies to ensure embedded learning.

Underpinning the programme is the methodology of sustained school improvement to empower staff to structure the school’s approach to delivery, ensuring a viable and effective strategy for the teaching of English within the curriculum.

Breakdown of LEAP 19 Offer:		
1.	Attendance at a Launch Event – 25.9.19: Attendance at ‘Closing the Gap’ Launch event to ensure smooth commencement and implementation of the project.	✓
2.	Professional Learning Communities: The schools will be grouped geographically to identify Hubs that will meet each half term as a Professional Learning Community (PLC), each will be led by a Hub Lead. Each school will nominate a ‘School Learning Champion’ to work within the Hub for the duration of the project, who’s role will be to disseminate expertise and leadership directly back to school.	✓
3.	Individual LLE support: Every school in the project will be supported by a LEAP Local Leader of Education (LLE) who will work directly with the Head teacher to analyse school information through a ‘Deep Dive’ discussion and direct the support to ensure maximum impact for children most at risk. The LLE will maintain contact with the school for the duration of the project to support and advise school leaders as appropriate and provide additional support as needed	✓
4.	Knowledge, Skills and Strategies Pathway: Schools will be offered a pathway to drill down further into the knowledge gained through the PLCs. The Pathway will include workshops from outside providers as well as SLEs working across LTT. 11 modules in total.	✓
5.	Attendance at a Legacy Event – tbc: Attendance at ‘Closing the Gap’ Legacy event to review impact of project, collate Case Studies	✓
