## Subject Leadership Development

### 2021/2022

Two half day courses led by one of our SLEs, Lorna O'Dwyer based at Long Sutton Primary School. Lorna has supported a number of schools in developing their subject leaders in order to drive school improvement across a curriculum area and has a wealth of knowledge to share. The 2 half day sessions are designed to support subject leaders to develop a more strategic understanding of school improvement within a subject area. The courses are suitable for experienced subject leaders and those who are new to role.

The 2 half days will focus upon the following areas:

- Leadership skills
- The role of a middle leader
- Developing the tools to systematically monitor and evaluate teaching and learning
- Using data to assess impact
- Action planning
- Understanding the new Ofsted framework

[Developing the tools to systematically monitor and evaluate teaching and learning – 12th October 2021 1.15-4.15pm](#)

The first of the two courses will focus upon the systematic approach needed to monitor and evaluate a subject area. This will enable subject leaders to become more strategic and less operational.

The course will focus upon the following areas:

- The planning of monitoring activities using a monitoring and evaluation schedule
- How to monitor and evaluate teaching and learning
- Ensuring triangulation of monitoring activities
- Drawing conclusions to ensure a strategic approach

This option can be attended as a stand-alone session.

Cost: £50 per person

### [Using data to assess impact and action planning – 2nd March 2022 1.15-4.15pm](#)

The second of the two courses is designed to develop a detailed understanding of data analysis within a subject area. It will allow those attending the course to be able to identify the strengths and areas for development within a subject, and to develop a strategic action plan which will support school improvement.

The course will focus upon the following areas:

- How to analyse subject data and draw conclusions from it
- How to identify strengths and areas for development within a subject using data
- How to set targets and develop strategic action plans based upon data and monitoring activities

This option can be attended as a stand-alone session.

Cost - £50 per person

#### **Discounted option**

Attend both courses and the cost will be reduced to £90.
