# Leading CPD to have an Impact

## Effective Continuous Professional Development Programme

This programme aims to ensure that leaders play a significant and informed role in securing effective CPD for themselves and their staff, building a robust understanding of the most appropriate programmes available to them to impact on their school's pupil outcomes and staff development. In order to impact upon pupil outcomes, leaders need to develop an understanding of the 5 pillars and the DfE golden thread of CPD. 1:1 Coaching sessions available throughout the programme.

**Session 1:** Effective Continuous Professional Development Programme conference for all leaders across Lincolnshire. Keynote Speaker – David Weston – “What makes Effective CPD?” Creating an effective approach to CPD in school – next steps in implementing a strategic approach and policy to CPD including sharing frameworks.

**Session 2:** Expert input from Maria Cunningham TDT – “Effective Needs Analysis” - assessment of CPD within school - knowledge / concepts / skills.

**Session 3:** Exploration of implementing small scale CPD cycle in school using Lesson study or similar. Expert input to support CPD lead in the school / setting.

**Session 4:** Impact event where CPD leaders meet to share small scale projects. Next steps

**Intended impact:** Delegates will be clear on the intended impact of professional development upon pupils and teachers and use formative assessment to gauge the impact of professional development and practices, adapting their approaches (with expert guidance) accordingly. Overall, delegates will engage in processes that both challenge/disrupt and deepen/extend their thinking.
