#### 1. Introduction to Sophie Lougher - ECF/AB Lead

After graduating with a PCGE in Education in 2014, I have nine years experience in the education sector. The first five of those were in Lincolnshire as a Primary School Teacher, teaching across the Early Years Foundation Stage and Key Stage Two. I worked as a school-based mentor for ECTs (previously NQTs) and for Initial Teacher Training (ITT) Students. 
## 2. Farewell from Stacey Williams

## 3. Updated statutory guidance

Please be aware that the statutory guidance for the induction of early career teachers (England) was revised in April 2023. This came into force on 1st September 2023.

## 4. Updated editable ECT Policy from September 2023

On ECT Manager, under the 'Resources' tab, 'Paperwork Templates' folder, please find attached an editable ECT policy updated for September 2023 that can be used to support any changes that need to be made to any existing early career teacher / induction policies.

We hope that you find this useful when updating your own school policy.

## **5.** ECT status on the DfE Manage Training for Early Career Teachers Services

L.E.A.D. Teaching School Hub Appropriate Body began confirming induction from 6th September 2023. Once ECT registrations have been authorised, records are updated with the Teaching Regulation Agency (TRA) at 4pm Monday-Friday.

The status of ECTs on the DfE's **Manage Training** for Early Career Teachers should then change from 'waiting for induction to be recorded.' Please be aware that this can take 24-48 hours to show. If an ECT's status does not change after this time, please contact us so that we can investigate.

#### 6. Steps for registering an ECT for an ECF-based statutory induction

The DfE opened registration for all ECTs and Mentors in mid July, 2023. In order to support schools, we produced specific step by step instructions. Please read the options here carefully to ensure that you access the correct steps. If you are unsure which school scenario best fits you, please contact **Rachael Viscomi** using the contact details at the bottom of this email.

#### **Group A**

If your position fits one of the following, please click **here** for your registration instructions:

- you already have ECTs registered with us;
- you are registering ECTs for the first time having had no previous partnership with any other ECF Provider or Appropriate Body;
- you only want to register with us for Appropriate Body services and not for ECF because you use the DfE-accredited materials to deliver your own ECF (core) or school based design route for this;
- you are keeping current ECTs with your current provider(s) but wish to move to L.E.A.D. Teaching School Hub for all new registrations from September 2023; or
- you have no current year 1 ECTs to bring over into year 2 and are only registering new ECTs to your school from September 2023.

#### **Group B**

If your position fits the following, please click here for your registration instructions:

 you are currently with another provider for appropriate body and your ECF led programme and you want to move your current ECTs over to L.E.A.D. Teaching School Hub as your Delivery Partner and Education Development Trust as Lead Provider alongside registering new ECTs and Mentors in the future.



#### 7. ECT contract details and roles reminder

Please ensure that the contract information tab for the ECT on ECT Manager is up to date. This is especially important for ECTs that are continuing with L.E.A.D. Teaching School Hub Appropriate Body this term who began induction last academic year. Please also check that the Headteacher, Mentor and Induction Tutor details are also correct.



#### 8. Free ASE membership

ASE (The Association for Science Education) understand that a strong community of support and professional development opportunities in the early stages of a teaching career can be vital. That's why they're offering student teachers **free membership** for the first two years of their training. Furthermore, they will be offering a 50% discount for the third year of membership, to support during this crucial phase of professional development.
